Triathlon[®] Trial Cutting Guide (TCG) Surgical overview

Delivering workflow efficiency in Revision TKA:

1. Create tibial platform Augment as necessary to establish tibial platform. Insert trial augments and trial tibial baseplate.



2. Establish joint line and extension gap Reference the medial epicondyle to set joint line. Fill extension gap with appropriate trial insert. Pin through slot.



3. Evaluate flexion gap Dynamically offset flexion gap to restore posterior condylar offset.



4. Establish femoral rotation Rotate component to establish appropriate rotation based on EPI line and patella tracking.







5. Make augment and box cuts

After trialing, visualize and perform clean up cuts or augment cuts through the TCG. Perform box cut.
