## Injectable Regenerative Graft

Pro-Dense LoVisc is a resorbable, regenerative bone void filler that can be injected or digitally packed into open bone voids that are not intrinsic to the stability of the bony structure of the skeletal system to cure in situ.

These open bone voids may be the result of benign bone cysts and tumors in adults and pediatric patients 6 years and older, surgically created osseous defects or osseous defects created from traumatic injury to the bone.

### **Extended** working time

Pro-Dense LoVisc supports filling with an uninterrupted bolus and adds flexibility to prep and application.

### Easy injectability

Pro-Dense LoVisc allows for minimally invasive delivery of larger graft volumes and grants one-handed functionality.

#### Predictable bone regeneration

Pro-Dense LoVisc graft sets, is radiopaque, and regenerates stronger, denser new bone.<sup>1</sup>
